## Pre-Kindergarten / Kindergarten Registration for 2020-2021



**April 28-30, 2020**

8:00 am until 3:00 pm – Thursday, April 30 until 6:30 pm

**STEP 1** - Complete Online Registration beginning on April 20th.

**STEP 2** - Take required documents to your student's campus  
April 28th-30th.

All new Pre-K students will register at Coder Elementary.

### DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR REGISTRATION:

- Proof of Residency  
(electric, water, or gas bill or home purchase agreement or lease agreement)
- Parent/Guardian's Driver's License
- Certified Birth Certificate
- Child's Social Security Card
- Current Immunization Records

*You must complete the online registration prior to bringing documents.*

## Pre-K Registration

To enroll in Pre-K, your student must meet this specific criteria. Parents must fill out the Pre-K application located on the Aledo ISD Pre-K/Kinder Department webpage and bring it with you to Coder Elementary during registration. You will be notified if your student meets the criteria.

To be eligible for enrollment in a Pre-Kindergarten class, a child must be at least four years of age as of September 1, 2020, and must:

- be either unable to speak and comprehend the English language; or
- be from a family that is eligible to participate in the National School Lunch program for free or reduced lunches; or
- be homeless; or
- be the child of an active duty member of the United States Armed Forces, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the Armed Forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority; or
- be the child of a member of the United States Armed Forces, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the Armed Forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty; or
- have ever been in the conservatorship of the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services (foster care) following an adversary hearing; or
- is the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as:
  - (1) a peace officer under Section 3106.002, Government Code;
  - (2) a firefighter under section 3106.003, Government Code; or
  - (3) an emergency medical first responder under Section 3106.004, Government Code.

To determine eligibility for students who do not speak and comprehend the English language, a home language survey and an oral proficiency instrument will be administered.
