

Below are the responsibilities for "Parents of Participants"

Attend Parent/Student Workshop

March 7 or 8 – The purpose of the workshop is to discuss information about responsibilities and complete all permission forms necessary for students to participate.

Mock Obituary

April 7 – Student obituaries are due in the counselor's office before April 7. The loss of a student affects everyone. To demonstrate this, we ask that parents fill out the student obituary form online and send in a recent 4X6 photo to attach to it

Parent Letter

April 7 – Parent letters need to be sealed in an envelope with their son or daughter's name on the front and returned to the counselor's office before April 7. This letter allows parents to express their feelings, expectations, hopes, and dreams for their son or daughter. Our hope is that this letter will open the door of communication necessary to keep parents informed and safe.

Mock Death Notification

April 7 – List the location and contact information for Mock Death Notification. The uniformed officer will be contacting you at this number to notify you of your child's death.

Shattered Dreams Assembly / parent_student reunification

April 21 – Parents should attend the Shattered Dreams Assembly at Aledo High School on **April 21 from 10:00 a.m.-11:30 a.m.** to summarize the entirety of the program. The assembly will feature a motivating speech from a guest speaker, as well as school staff, and students. After the assembly, parents will be given the opportunity to reconnect with their son or daughter in the administration building. A short debriefing session with parent/student will conclude the Shattered Dreams Program.
