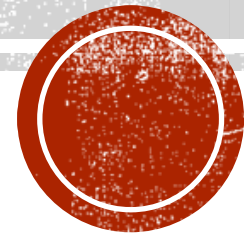

# IMPORTANT DATES

## How the program goes:

### **Program Day 1 = April 20**

- Advisory period, video shown (video to be shot with selected students on future date)
- Every 15 minutes: student participants (living dead) are announced as dead to class, have obit read and posted; when this happens parents receive death notification from law enforcement; students have faces painted white, are then silent for the rest of the day
- Lunch provided to student participants at off-site location
- 3:00 all student participants depart for overnight leadership retreat



# **IMPORTANT DATES**

## **How the program goes:**

### **Program Day 2 = April 21**

- Student participants return to school
- 10:00 at AHS is a program assembly; PARENTS ATTEND!
- Approx. 11:30 – assembly concludes, student participants taken to debrief the two days; parents to separate room to debrief the two days
- Approx. noon – students and parents reunited



# SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARENTS

- Complete and submit obituary for your child, including picture
  - **Student Services** web page on AISD site
  - Due to AHS counseling office no later than **APRIL 7**
- Write a letter to your student participant
  - Share your hopes and aspirations for them
  - State what they mean to you
  - Due to AHS counseling office – in a sealed envelope with student's first and last name – no later than **APRIL 7**



# SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARENTS

- Be available for mock death notification sometime on **April 20**
  - Loose form in packet – list location/phone number
  
- Attend Shattered Dreams assembly/debriefing/reunification
  - AHS (exact location TBD – notice will be sent via email)
  - **April 21 @ 10:00am**



# SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES OF STUDENTS

- Keep aware of possible conflicts on April 20/21
- Pack according to overnight retreat checklist provided
- Check in at AHS main gym at **7:00am – APRIL 20**
- **NO PHONES or ELECTRONICS** of any kind, beginning at 7:00am on April 20
